Many beer drinkers want to know who makes their beer. The Independent Craft Brewers seal makes it easy to differentiate beer from independent craft brewers and beer produced by other, non-craft companies.

When eating out, always ask your waiter for local craft beer.

Independent Craft Brewers of Iceland is a non profit organization that works to promote and protect small and independent Icelandic breweries and their craft beers. The organization stands for quality, craftsmanship and independence.

The history of Craft Beer in Iceland is a short one. In 1908 the consumption of alcohol was banned in Iceland and while the ban was lifted in 1933, beer with an ABV greater than 2.25% still remained illegal. It wasn't untill March 1, 1989 that beer was finally legalized again.

Ever since then, March 1 is known as Beer Day in Iceland.

In the beginning, large industrial breweries and imports dominated the Icelandic markets. The story of independent craft brewing started in 2006 when Kaldi in Árskógssandur up north, became the first Icelandic microbrewery and Ölvisholt, located at an old dairy farm in the south followed soon thereafter. Since then microbreweries have popped up in different parts of Iceland and the members of **ICBI** are around twenty.

They are as different as they are many with various styles and approaches, united by the seal of quality and craftsmanship. There is bound to be something for everyone.

ICBI beers may be found in most better bars in Iceland and Vinbudin, the government run liquor store that has outlets in many locations around the country.

Please enjoy responsibly and remember that drinking and driving is completely and absolutely forbidden in Iceland.
